

Greetings from the Antique Wooden Boat Show Dockside Traders' Committee. Read with care. Preparations are underway for the 32nd Annual Antique Wooden Boat Show and Festival of Arts to be held on Saturday, August 8, 2009. Fourteen single spaces (size 12 ft x 12 ft.) will be available to those who market items associated with boats and boating. Single Spaces will be assigned on a first postmark basis. The Space may not be sublet to other parties. Spaces are not transferable. If a firm finds they cannot use their space, they must contact the Dockside Trader committee as soon as possible, so that those on the waiting list qualify.

As you know, the main focus of our show is the antique wooden boat. Spaces for this section are limited to fourteen single spaces. These spaces will be located behind the Mertaugh Boat Works Sale Center (between the rear of the building and the lake) on a dolomite gravel area. As before, you may not park your vehicle or large trailers in the Dockside Traders' site. As a show participant, you will have an assigned parking area. Traffic flow has pre-determined directions due to the limited show space in this community.

Smoking or drinking alcohol within the gated show premises is not permitted. Only working dogs specifically trained for seeing eye etc. are allowed on site. **STAKES CANNOT BE DRIVEN INTO THE DOCKSIDE TRADERS' AREA! PLAN ACCORDINGLY.** If you participate in more than one show area, you may need additional drivers or display sitters.

SHOW POLICY: Firms which market sweatshirts, polo shirts, T-shirts or other wearing apparel may not exhibit or sell these items. Firms which market boats, docks, or lifts may not display the aforementioned because of our space restrictions and because the primary focus of the show must be the Antique Wooden Boats. They are, however, most welcome to post story boards, picture displays, and dispense literature. No raffle tickets may be sold for other organizations other than those by Les Cheneaux Historical Association.

Vendors will set up their displays early on SATURDAY Morning. Mertaugh Boat Works has many responsibilities on Friday evening. **DOCKSIDE TRADERS CANNOT SET UP ON FRIDAY.** Vender assumes full liability for any risk or loss. Vendors will receive two (2) admission passes per vendor. Additional passes are available (\$7.00 per adult, \$3.00 per younger person / age12-18, and children under 12 are admitted free.) If a firm forgets their admission passes the day of the show, they will be expected to pay admission.
